Only in Cedar Hill can you find such great shopping and dining so close to so much natural fun.

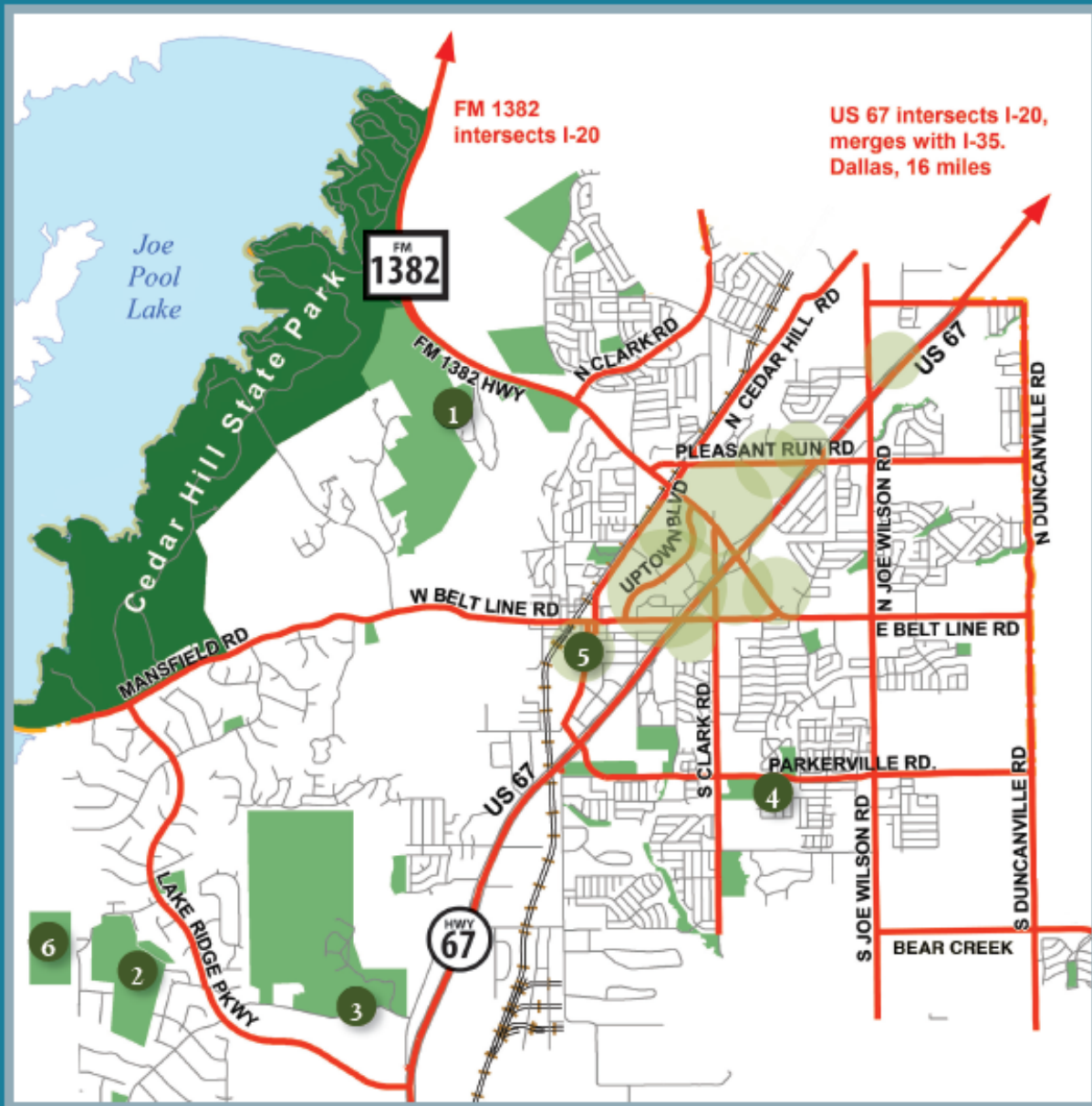
